

Orissa Police District Headquarter, Nayagarh

The princely state of Nayagarh after independent was Sub-Division of undivided Puri district. Following the Re-organisation of the districts in Odisha in 1993 Nayagarh Police district was formed and started functioning with effect from 1.4.1993 after bifurcation from its parent district Puri. Sri B.N Jha, IPS was the first S.P. of this district and he held the post from 1.4.1993 to 31.4.1993. The district of Nayagarh lies between 19°54" to 20°32" North Latitude and 84°29" to 85°27" East Longitude. The border of Nayagarh touches the district of Angul and Cuttack in North and North west, Boudh and Kandhamala in the west, Ganjam in south and Khorda in East. The total Geographical area of Nayagarh District is 3890 sq. K.Ms. There is one Subdivision i.e. Nayagarh Sub-Division and 3 Police Sub-Division i.e. Nayagarh, Khandapada and Sarankul, 8 Tahasil, 179 G.Ps. 2 NACs, 1689 villages, 3 parliamentary constituencies. The total Population is 864506 (2001 Census) and the principal occupation of people is agriculture, Agricultural labour and forest product. Major portion of the district is covered with hilly terrains, highlands and dense forest. Topography is undulated. It has got hilly ranges in the west and the North West. The middle part is scraped by cultivated fertile valleys intersected by small streams. The climate carries high temperature rising up to 44 Degree Celsius in hot month and cooler about 11 degree Celsius in winter.

There are 9 P.Ss at the beginning of the dist. After enhancement the number of P.S. comes to 13 including 1 Energy P.S. Under the district 325 Home Guards including 41 L.H.Gs. are working as auxiliary force to help the dist Police in maintaining Law and order and traffic duty. Besides 46 numbers of Special Police officers are also working in the district.

LAW & ORDER:-

Law and order situation always anticipated during observance of fairs and festivals, visit of VIPs & VVIPs, agitational programs by various political activities/labour organizations, elections & incidents occurred on sudden provocation. On some occasions law and order situation is also required to be maintained by the police pertaining to some crime and criminals.

Apart from above, police has to cater the L & O problems relating to various agitational programs in case of vehicular accident the local villagers closed to the accidental spots are resorting to regular Rasta Rok being organized by the agitators in supports of Road accident cases resulting in disruption of vehicular traffic.

Demonstrations by different political parties organizations before Collectorate, Nayagarh and rally inside Nayagarh are common phenomena which requires deployment of police force.

The over all L/O situation of Nayagarh dist in the year 2009 & 2010 remained as remarkably peaceful inspite of the fact that several major events were observed. The parliamentary and assembly election 2009 were held in march 2009 without any major incident and past off peacefully and smoothly.

The Car festival observed at Nayagarh ,Ranpur,and khandapada P.S area were massive crowd gathered to witness the festivals not a single untoward incident took place due to vigilant and meticulous planning by the different wings of the Dist Police. Rama Nabami of Odagaon , Mahasivaratri of Sarankul,Bhouma Ekadasi at kantilo ,LankaPodi at Dasapalla, Kalapatta Yatra at Gania,Ranpur Mohatsaba and Nayagarh Mohatshaba passed off peace fully without any incident in the various part of Nayagarh district due to alertness of dist Police.

Movement of VIPs on NH-224 is quite frequent for which escort/pilot-cum- protection parties are detailed regularly for security. The CM of Odisha and Governor of Odisha are also visiting this district for which special police arrangement are made with deployment of officers and staff to deal with any eventuality. In many occasion the L/O arises due to caste fiction among the villagers.

OBJECTIVES :-

Maintenance of L & O, prevention and detection of crime in the district is primary duty of the Police to facilitate the public for leaving with all peace and tranquility.

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE OF THE DISTRICT IS GIVEN BELOW:-

The district Police office is functioning with Establishment section ,Accounts section ,Integrated D.C.R.B.,D.H.R.P.C,D.I.B.& Reserve Office .Under the administrative control of D.P.O. Nayagarh 13 Police Station,12 OPs , 02 Beat House,03 SDPO office and 04 Police Court offices i.e. Sadar Court office, Ranpur Court office, Khandapada Court office and Daspalla Court office are functioning with the following strength.

.All the IsIC & OsIC have been directed to remain alert and maintain L/O to avert any unpleasant situation /incident in there respective jurisdiction .They have been impressed upon to active their staff to lunch various drives to nab smugglers and curb upon manufacture/ transportation /sale of liquor and ganja in their respective P.S. jurisdiction. IIC & OICs advised to ensure opening of antisocial history sheet of accused persons involved in excise cases . All P.S. level officers have been instructed to organize special drive to execute warrants in their P.S. and to book diehard antisocial to maintain peace.

They have been advised to prepare gang profiles and guard against occurrence of organized crime like docoit, robberies by keeping surveillance on such criminals, QRT with arms .mobile phone have been

provided to control and detect heinous crimes. They have been instructed to collect intelligence regarding religious conversion. The Police personnel of this district are advised to keep sharp lookout over the movement/activities of extremists and take counter offensive steps to neutralize extremists' activities, combing operations being intensified in affected areas to track down Maoists. All field officers are advised to sensitize to all the field functionaries to keep sharp watch over the communal situation and attend all matters relating land dispute and visit spot followed by enquiry and submit P.R. Special striking force, DVF team and special Police officers with QRT van have been formed and deployed in the sensitive Police station like Ranpur, Banigochha, & Daspalla P.S. areas. To improve the Police public relations and to promote communal harmony SRE camp are being organized by the district Police in different remote areas where medicines, sports items and clothing's are being presented to public and youngsters.

ACHIEVEMENTS:-

Due to deployment of adequate police force at Ganesh Puja, Biswakarma, Durga Puja, Laxmi Puja, Hingula Yatra & measure festive like Rama Nabami, Shiba Chaturthi, Maha Siva Ratri, Bhauma Ekadasi Yatra, Lanka Podi, Ranpur Mahostav and other festive passed off peacefully.

No major L & O situation has so far taken place in this district due to deployment of police personnel to the above said strategic location as and where necessary for maintenance of peace and tranquility of this district.

SISHU DESK.

Though there is no Mahila P.S in this district Mahila and Sishu desk have been set up in all the 12 Police stations of this district and functioning with required staffs from amongst the present strength of the respective P.Ss. One officer in the rank of SI./ ASI in each P.S. have been designated as desk officers and attached to the desk to receive all complaints relating to women and child victims
